Dr. Peter Whitehouse, MD, PhD (Psychology)

Peter Whitehouse is a Professor of Neurology at Case Western Reserve University, Ohio. With colleagues he discovered fundamental aspects of the cholinergic pathology in Alzheimer's and related dementias. He founded with his wife, Catherine, The Intergenerational School, a unique public multiage, community school. As the author (with Danny George) of *The Myth of Alzheimer's: What You Aren't Being Told About Today's Most Dreaded Diagnosis* he will transform the way we look at the aging brain.

Dr. Yin-Hui Siow, MD

Yin-Hui Siow is a Radiologist at Southlake Regional Health Centre. He is the Director of Nuclear Medicine and is a past Chief of Diagnostic Imaging.

Dr. Mary Fox, RN, PhD

Mary Fox is an Associate Professor in the School of Nursing at York University. Her research on the Acute Care for Elders (ACE) model was selected for summary as best new evidence for internal medicine by the American College of Physicians Journal Club of *Annals of Internal Medicine*.
